SMALL BUSINESS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANTS

Does your business need new signage or a fresh coat of paint? Help with marketing or accounting? As a building or business owner you can apply for a Small Business Technical Assistance (SBTA) grant which helps with both physical and operational improvements. The grant program is designed to strengthen and promote equity among the businesses that create a vibrant, unique, and historic environment along the GMS commercial corridor. SBTA grants cover up to 90% of costs for two types of projects – storefront and interior improvements, and business operation improvements.
